Competitors should not enter more than 3 events (excluding Club events). All events are subject to four to enter & three to row.

As the regatta is using the new competition structure, if sufficient numbers are available for each event, these may be split by ranking points.

For masters events please enter all crew as master's 'A', the eventual category of the crew will depend on numbers, age and experience. Events may be raced by masters age in which case a handicap system will apply at the start in line with British Rowing guidelines, or ranking points, with no handicap.

Chester-le-Street Regatta will be using the British Rowing on-line entry system (BROE2). All entry fees must be paid on-line by Monday 24th April for crews to be included in the draw. No e-mail, postal or telephone entries allowed.
