Notes

Due to early date of the event, competitors (excluding coxes) should not enter more than 2 events. All events are subject to four to enter, if entries permit this may be lowered. Events may be amalgamated if sufficient numbers are not available. In the event of the competition reaching its safety limit before the closing date, it may be closed sooner.

The regatta is using the new competition structure, if sufficient numbers are available for each event, these may be banded by ranking points.

For masters events please enter in the appropriate age category, the eventual category the crew races in will depend on numbers and age. Events will be raced by masters age in which case a handicap system will apply at the start in line with British Rowing guidelines.

Chester-le-Street Regatta will be using the British Rowing on-line entry system (BROE2). All entry fees must be paid on-line by Monday 4th April for crews to be included in the draw. No e-mail, postal or telephone entries allowed.
