Entries will open on Saturday 28th March at 6pm and officially close at 9 pm on Thursday 9th April 2026. The draw will be made at Chester-le-Street Rowing Club on Monday 13th April 2026 and will appear online by Tuesday 14th April on the club website and on EasyRegatta on the day.

Notes

Doubling up is permitted between divisions, but no doubling up of any competitor or cox in the same division. Boats and blades may be doubled up in divisions as long as provisions are made by clubs in case the boats is required by both crews at the same time. The organisers are not able to alter race time on the day.

All events are subject to four to enter, if entries permit this may be lowered. Events may be amalgamated if sufficient numbers are not available. In the event of the competition reaching its safety limit before the closing date, it may be closed sooner.

BR Rowing Competition framework will be used. Senior events will be split into bands of similar ranking index (RI). For masters events please enter in the category the crew wishes to race. Entries will be grouped by age, and the British Rowing handicap system will be applied at the Start. Masters crews that cannot be accommodated in this way will be offered to matching band in senior class with similar RI. Juniors without opposition will be moved to a higher age band or may be offered Senior class where RI will be used, if crews do not wish to be moved then please indicate this on BROE.

Chester-le-Street Regatta will be using the British Rowing on-line entry system (BROE2). Day tickets will be allowed at this event. All entry fees must be paid on-line by Monday 13th April for crews to be included in the draw. No e-mail, postal or telephone entries allowed.
